

2. For unit price/s, quotations with a **dash or zero shall be deemed free of charge**.
3. All entries must be typewritten/printed/longhand. **Any erasure in the quotation must be countersigned by the bidder/representative**, otherwise quotation will be rejected.
4. The Procuring Entity **may give due preference to goods being offered with green component**.
5. If necessary, the BAC through the TWG, may require an ocular inspection of the venue/place of business/goods being offered.
6. Delivery of Goods / Services is **as indicated** in the next page.
7. Price validity shall be for a period of **120 calendar days from RFQ Opening of the BAC until confirmation of Purchase Order by the winning supplier**.
8. The following documents shall be attached upon submission of quotation, otherwise your quotation will not be accepted, please disregard if already submitted:
 - a. **Updated Mayor's / Business Permit**

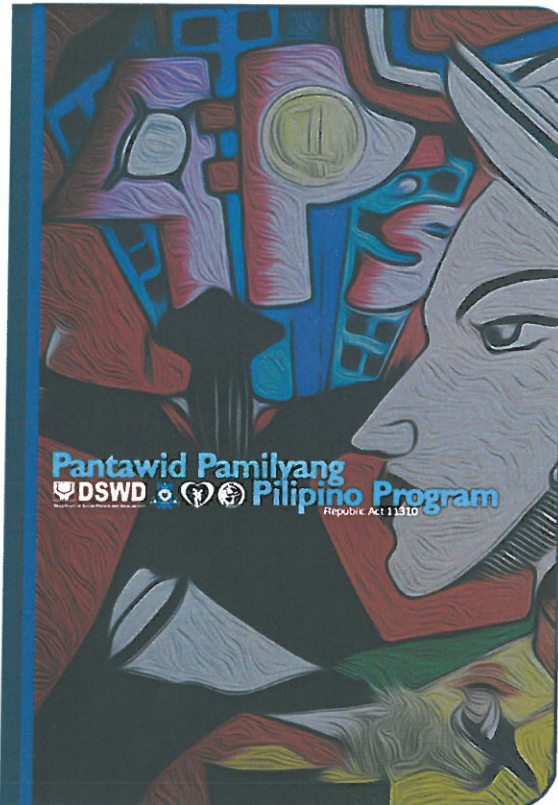

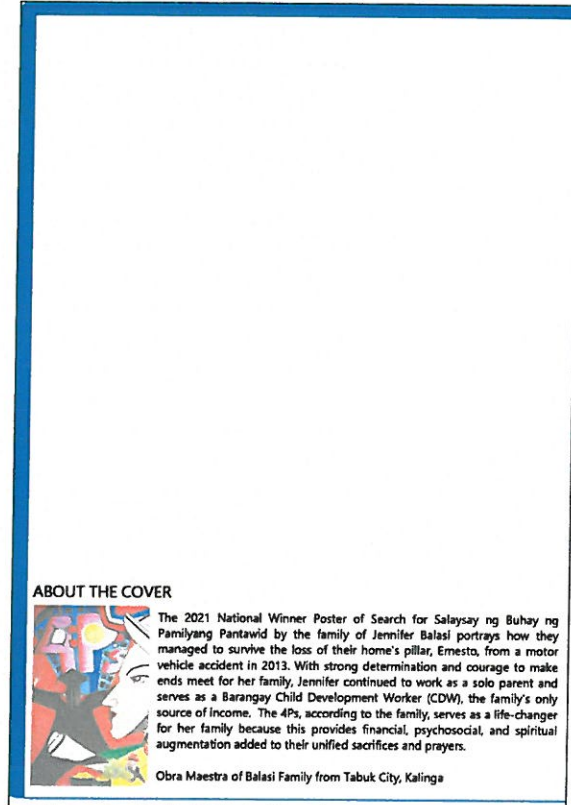

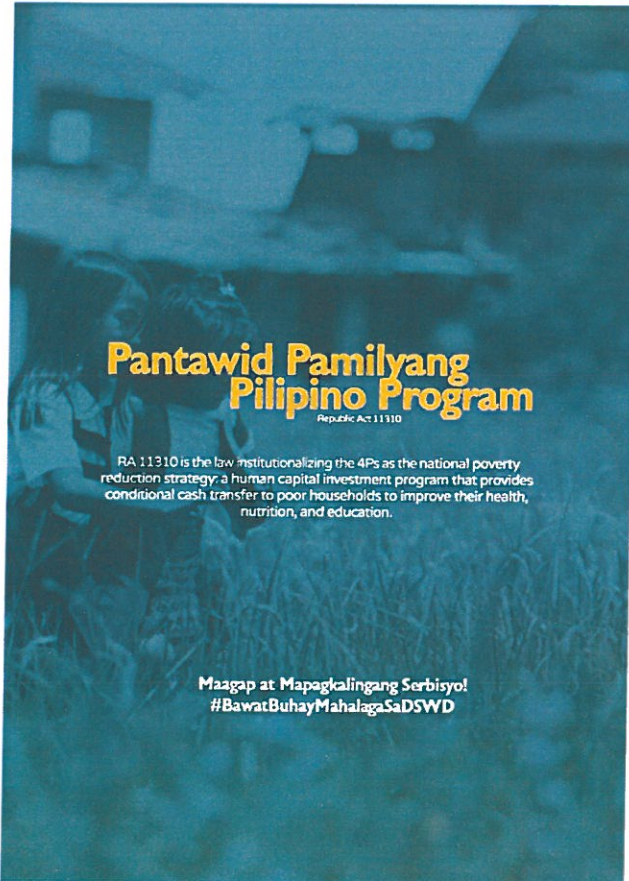

The 4Ps Law at a Glance

Eligible Beneficiaries Section 6

To be eligible for cash grants, poor and near-poor households or families must be willing to comply with the conditions and meet any of the following criteria:

- 0-18 years old
- Pregnant at the time of registration

Farmers, fisherfolks, homeless families, indigenous peoples, informal settlers, and those in geographically isolated and disadvantaged areas are automatically included in the standardized targeting system implemented by the DSWD but will still have to meet the criteria to be eligible for cash grants






