- 6. Delivery of Goods / Services is as indicated in the next page.
- 7. Price validity shall be for a period of 120 calendar days from RFQ Opening of the BAC until confirmation of Purchase Order by the winning supplier.

Administrative Support:

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) is the primary government agency mandated to develop, implement and coordinate social protection and poverty-reduction solutions for and with the poor. vulnerable and disadvantaged. The retrofitting of the RRCY Covered Court Building is key in ensuring the safety of the occupants and is a prerequisite for the continued skills development of the residents, as the basements will serve as the skills development facility of the center. The building is located at RRCY, Bayabas, Sablan, Benguet.

The DSWD is seeking Technical Assistance from the private sector to guarantee the structural integrity of the RRCY Covered Court located at Bayabas, Sablan, Benguet, The RRCY Covered Court was built in 2019. When the Magnitude 7.0 earthquake happened on July 27, 2022, the BGMS team inspected all DSWD infrastructures including the RRCY Covered Court. During the inspection, it was found out that the structural columns were not implemented according to the plans. The actual span of columns is longer compared to the structural plans and posts a risk for failure. In line with these findings, the BGMS team requested for Technical Assistance from the Department of Public Works and Highways - CAR (DPWH-CAR) to assess the building if it is still structurally safe given the initial findings.

The DPWH-CAR sent a team of Engineers and Architects, accompanied by the BGMS team, to assess the structure. Resulting from this assessment, the DPWH-CAR team sent a report recommending to contract the services of a highly technical private structural engineer for consultancy regarding the non-destructive tests and structural analysis of the building. This consultancy would also include the design of possible retrofitting works, subject to the result of the structural analysis and non-destructive tests, for the structure of the building. Contracting a highly technical structural engineer with the expertise and capability would ensure the safety and integrity of the existing structure.

Following governing laws & regulations such as but not limited to the National Building Code and National Structural Code of the Philippines (NSCP) 2015.

The CONSULTANT shall work in close collaboration with DSWD in-house technical staff, the Buildings and Grounds Management Section (BGMS), who shall serve as its liaison to the different offices and departments of the DSWD.

As a general principle, the CONSULTANT shall perform the tasks laid down below in full consideration of all pertinent laws, rules and regulations of the government and the DSWD.

These terms of reference provide the basic/standard requirements for the conduct of consulting services to be rendered for the project.

DETAILS

1. Competence and Qualifications:

Should be a practicing Registered Civil Engineer specializing in Structural Engineering with at least ten (10) years extensive experience in design and structural computations of buildings and projects of similar or greater magnitude and complexity.

Relevant Projects shall refer to contracts with scope of works related to the preparation of structural design and detailed engineering of other vertical structures (government / public and private buildings).

Prospective Consultants are required to submit the following:

- 1. Certificate of Registration from BIR;
- 2. Official Receipt from BIR;
- 3. Valid PhilGEPS Registration Certificate (at least RED membership) (all pages); and
- 4. Curriculum Vitae

2. Scope of Works:

The consultant is expected to provide the following:

- Conduct non-destructive tests of existing beams and columns. The results of which shall be the basis of the retrofit design.
- 2. Perform structural analysis of the existing building based on the as-built drawings.
- 3. Produce the Retrofit Design to be structurally compliant to the provisions of the National Structural Code of the Philippines.
- 4. Produce signed and sealed structural rehabilitation drawings and specifications (at least 7 copies).
- 5. Visit the project site five (5) times during the implementation of the retrofitting works to ensure that the plans and specifications are being implemented accordingly.

3. Detailed Estimate:

4. Other Provisions:

The consultant on its own account shall provide all office supplies, equipment, instruments, machines, vehicles and manpower necessary in the performance of its duties and obligations.

In the event the DSWD requires revisions in the detailed approved plans due to site conditions, the consultant shall submit the necessary revised plans, specifications and justifications at no additional cost to DSWD.

The consultant must be available during the construction stage to remedy any conflict or problems arising from the defects or deficiencies in design on an "on call" basis.

All outputs of the consultant will belong to the DSWD and the DSWD has the right to utilize these outputs for any and all its future infrastructure projects. The CONSULTANT shall take measures to ensure that any data on the DSWD matters which will affect its security shall be handled with confidentiality.

5. Accountabilities

Close coordination and regular communication with the DSWD, official and/or staff will therefore be an integral part of the scope of work.

The DSWD shall have full access to any information, data, documents or working records acquired or used by the Consultant during the course of the project.

The DSWD or any of its authorized representatives may participate in project meetings and join the Consultant during onsite inspections or meetings with the regulated entities. Communication with the regulated entities shall be conducted through the DSWD.

6. Contract Duration and Schedule

Required outputs shall be completed and submitted within Thirty (30) calendar days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed. Five (5) site visits of the consultant during the retrofitting works shall be scheduled by the DSWD. This is excluded from the contract duration of Thirty (30) calendar days.

Where the Consultant refuses or fails to satisfactorily complete the work within the specified contract time, plus any time extension duly granted and is hereby in default under the contract, the Consultant shall pay DSWD for liquidated damages, and not by way of penalty, an amount, as provided in the conditions of contract, equal to at least one tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the unperformed portion of the works for every day of delay. Should the amount of liquidated damages reach ten percent (10%) of the contract amount, DSWD shall, at its own discretion, terminate the contract without prejudice to any further action it may take to recover whatever losses incurred due to non-performance of the Consultant.

To be entitled to such liquidated damages, DSWD does not have to prove that it has incurred actual damages. Such amount shall be deducted from any money due or which may become due the Consultant under the contract and/or collect such liquidated damages from the retention money or other securities posted by the Consulting Firm whichever is convenient to DSWD.

7. Term of Payment

For and in consideration of the full and satisfactory performance of the services by the consultant and the acceptance thereof by the DSWD, the DSWD shall pay the agreed following fees in accordance with the billing schedules corresponding thereto:

- 1. 25% of the Contract Amount upon completion of items 1 and 2 under Scope of Works.
- 2. 50% of the Contract Amount upon completion of items 3 and 4 under Scope of Works.
- 3. 25% of the Contract Amount upon completion of item 5 under Scope of Works.
