1. Quotations in excess of the ABC will be **REJECTED**.
2. For total quoted price, quotations with a **dash or zero shall be deemed free of charge**.
3. All entries must be typewritten/printed/longhand. **Any erasure in the quotation must be countersigned by the bidder/representative**, otherwise quotation will be rejected.
4. The Procuring Entity **may give due preference to goods being offered with green component**.
5. If necessary, the BAC through the TWG, may require an ocular inspection of the venue/place of business/goods being offered.
6. Delivery of Goods / Services is **as indicated** in the next page.
7. Price validity shall be for a period of **120 calendar days from RFQ Opening of the BAC until confirmation of Purchase Order by the winning supplier**.
8. The following documents shall be attached upon submission of quotation, otherwise your quotation will not be accepted, please disregard if already submitted:
 - a. **Updated Mayor's / Business Permit**

Magkano ang badyet na inilalaan sa bawat bata?

Ang mga batang naka-enroll sa ilalim ng SFP ay binibigyan ng mga pagkain na nagkakahalaga ng Php21.00 bawat araw hot meals at Php21.00 para sa gatas.



Paano ang implementasyon ng Supplementary Feeding Program?

- Pagsasagawa ng feeding sa loob ng 5 hanggang 7 araw sa isang linggo sa loob ng CDCs at SNPs;
- Pagbibigay ng hot meals na binubuo ng kanin at ulam o kaya naman ay alternative meals na may kalidad na sustansya, na maaring ibigay sa oras ng recess or merienda ng mga bata; at
- Pagbibigay ng sariliwang gatas o anumang produktong gawa dito, mula sa ating lokal dairy farmer na binibigay sa mga batang kulang sa nutrisyon.



Paano ang implementasyon ng Supplementary Feeding Program sa panahon ng Community Quarantine at iba pang katulad na kalamidad?

Sa panahon ng Community Quarantine at iba pang katulad na kalamidad, ang implementasyon ng SFP ay pinalalawig sa mga sumusunod na paraan:

- House-to-house distribution ng lokal na pamahalaan sa pamamahagi ng hot meals o mga alternatibong pagkain sa tahanan ng mga batang benepeisyaryo;
- Pagtayo ng mobile community kitchen; at
- Paggamit ng Emergency Food Voucher kung saan kino-compute ang halagang Php21.00 sa loob ng 120 na araw kada bata o sa natitira pang mga araw para mabuo ang 120 na araw.



Paano sinusukat ang resulta ng Supplementary Feeding Program?

Ang mga batang benepeisyaryo ng SFP ay tititimbang sa pagsisimula ng programa at kada buwan hanggang makompleto ang 120 na araw upang malaman ang pagbabago sa kanilang nutritional status.



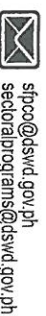
Ano ang ugnayan ng Debolusyon at Supplementary Feeding Program?

Ang Debolusyon ay ang paglipat ng karapatan, kapangyarihan, serbisyo, responsibilidad, at tamang pondo sa mas mababang antas mula sa sentral na pamahalaan tungo sa pamahalang lokal o pambihiryo. Ang SFP ay bahagi ng debolusyon. Sa sandaling magkabisang ang debolusyon, ang DSWD ay dapat tumutok sa paglatakda ng mga pamantayan sa paghahatid ng serbisyo, pagsuway-pay sa pagganap ng paghahatid ng serbisyo, at pagpapalatas ng mga LGU sa pamamagitan ng tulong teknikal at resource augmentation.
