

INVITATION FOR NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT – COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION

Purchase and Delivery of Food Supplies for the 15th Cycle of Supplementary Feeding Program in Pidigan, Abra NPCP 2025-05-003

- Certificate of registration from the DTI, SEC, CDA, DA, Department of Labor and Employment, NCIP; or in the case of Civil Society Organizations, Non-Government Organizations or Peoples' Organizations that are compliant with the requirements of a CSG, registration from NGA or LGU, and
