Rationale:

The Reception and Study Center for Children (RSCC) is a government residential care facility for children who are either abandoned, abused, surrendered, foundling, neglected, trafficked or dependent including those children with special needs needing temporary care. The admission age is 0-6 years old in case of sibling groups, the child/ren above 0-6 years old is/are admitted as siblings should not be separated from one another.

Prompt and best quality care provided to these children aimed to develop them physically, socially, emotionally and mentally while they are sheltered is necessary. They have different backgrounds, health problem, behaviors and cognitive abilities and they are vulnerable group thus deterioration could be prevented through appropriate care and interventions provided as soon as they are admitted to the center. While sheltered at RSCC, the children's needs have to be attended to promptly and properly thus the provision of programs and services based on need.

To conduct assessment and diagnosis as basis for the medicines and other necessary immunization/ vaccines which is included in the fees collected.
