- WHEREAS, the Department of Social Welfare and Development-Cordillera Administrative Region (DSWD-CAR) has been granted appropriations for the BOARD AND LODGING FOR THE TRAINING OF COUNSELORS ON PRE-MARRIAGE COUNSELING, MODULE 2 BANGUED, ABRA with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Sixty Five Thousand Pesos Only (₱65, 000.00);
- WHEREAS, in consonance with the Republic Act 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, a Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP) which has been consolidated into the Annual Procurement Plan (APP) is in order for procurement of the programs, activities and projects for 2021;
- WHEREAS, in consonance with the Republic Act 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, in its Implementing Rules and Regulations under Section 10, provides that "all procurement shall be done through competitive bidding, except as provided in Rule XVI";

- WHEREAS, section 53.10 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the RA 9184 or otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act of 2002 allows the procuring entity to resort to Negotiated Procurement LEASE OF VENUE;
- WHEREAS, on the 29th day of April 2021, Request for Quotations were transmitted to the End-User;
- WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of May 2021 at 12nn was the set deadline for the submission of quotations wherein three (3) price quotations were obtained from SENORITA LYDIA HOTEL, LUCKY'S HOTEL & RESTAURANT, and MT CARMEL AGRI-TOURISM AND TRAINING CENTER INC. On the other hand, RYJELL HOTEL cannot accommodate the activity due to pandemic. In pursuant to the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 under Lease of Venue and Small Value Procurement, the receipt of at least one (1) price quotation is sufficient to proceed with the evaluation thereof;
