- WHEREAS, the Department of Social Welfare and Development Cordillera Administrative Region (DSWD-CAR) has appropriations for the project, Purchase of Commercial Rice for the 10th Cycle Supplementary Feeding Program in Kalinga with an Approved Budget for the Contract amounting to One Million Three Hundred Eight Thousand Pesos (Php1,308,000.00);
- WHEREAS, Republic Act 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, in its Implementing Rules and Regulations under Section 10, provides that "all procurement shall be done through competitive bidding, except as provided in Rule XVI";
- WHEREAS, in consonance with the Republic Act 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, a Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP) for the project was incorporated and consolidated in the CY2019 Annual Procurement Plan (APP) of the Field Office adopting Public Bidding as mode of Procurement;
- WHEREAS, there are two (2) bidders signified interest and purchased bid documents from Calanan General Merchandise and Atipse Marketing and General Merchandise;
- WHEREAS, in reference to Resolution No. <u>087-2020</u>, Calanan General Merchandise was declared Lowest Calculated Bid and subjected for post-qualification by the Technical Working Group;
- WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group (TWG) submitted their findings and recommendation as a result of Post-qualification conducted with Calanan General Merchandise and presented to the BAC as follows:
 - Legally, technically and financially responsive
 - With enough resources and NFCC to undertake the project
 - Submitted a latest Income and Business Tax Returns filed through e-BIR
 - Line of business is in-line with the bidding at hand
- WHEREAS, the BAC deliberated the Post-Qualification Report on merit to the findings of the TWG upon determination that Calanan General Merchandise passes all the criteria for post-qualification and unanimously declared the bidder as Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB;

- Declare the bid of Calanan General Merchandise as the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid, and
